## Is the New Covenant in Jesus Christ

[ the "eternal covenant" as promised in Genesis 17:7 & Jeremiah 33 ; as fulfilled in Jesus Christ and taught in the New Testament (e.g., Hebrews 8) ]

## the same as the "Dispensation of Grace" ?

If the answer to the question above is:

"YES it is"

"NO it isn't"

then we ask ...

Then the dispensation of grace never ends, correct ?

When does the dispensation of grace end ?

Answer: ? (Please show EXPLICIT Bible evidence.)

IF it does end, then it's  
**NOT** the same as the  
New Covenant, correct?

IF it doesn't end, then aren't  
many dispensational charts  
**incorrect** ?



(because advocates of the position  
typically end the *dispensation of grace*  
at the close of the church age, which  
many say, is the Pre-Trib Rapture event)

Related question: *WHERE* in the Word of God is the  
*dispensation of grace* ever said to  
be "the church age" as defined by  
the Pre-Tribulationists ?

There are only two passages in the New Testament  
which use the word "dispensation" and that in only  
the KJV & NKJV *literal* versions of the Bible. (Our  
point: The NASB, ESV, NRSV, etc. don't even use  
the phrase "**dispensation** of grace" in the  
Ephesians 1 & 3 passages.) Let's define terms  
in light of Bible Counsel, not *theological opinion*.

Note: In addition to the poorly evidenced inference of *dispensationalism*, please also add this factual observation to this concern (regarding the strength of the Pre-Trib Rapture position): There is not ONE explicit passage in the Bible teaching the idea that the Church is raptured **before** the tribulation period ("tribulation" biblically defined – as opposed to Pre-Trib theological definition).
