You'll Thank Me Later

This "You'll thank me later" is <u>predicated on</u> | obviously conditional upon your actually doing what I suggest as outlined below. Let me explain.

The state of one's eternity is a big deal. While the *Fountain of Youth* (usually attributed to Ponce de León) is a myth, **eternal existence following our physical death is not**. Here's the catch:

There are two eternal-life places: Heaven (in God's presence and all the glory found only in Him) or Hell | the Lake of Fire (in the devil's presence and all the darkness he – satan – offers). Everyone will be in one or the other *state* through eternity. While it's a *no brainer* as to which place is preferable, many, nevertheless, choose darkness. How sad. Sad for God Who cares for those lost (as God desires all to come to salvation through faith in Jesus Christ His Son) and sad for us who will dwell in heaven and who also care having been given the heart of Christ for the lost. BUT eternal darkness will be most sad for those who insist upon that dark and most grievous destination. NO ONE has to go there as all of mankind has been given a chance to choose life in Jesus Christ. Will YOU, by faith, accept a glorious eternity OR will you reject God's loving salvation gift and choose the second death – eternal life in bitter darkness – with all that is evil? Remember, there's *weeping and gnashing of teeth* there.

Jesus Christ came to free mankind from eternal death – immortality in Hell – through the only means possible: Forgiveness of sin through His atoning sacrifice and restoration of spiritual life with God through His resurrection – victory over eternal death (sin's consequence).

So here's where I share the way to eternal glory in God's holy presence. Recall: IF you follow the Gospel Counsel, you will thank the God Who has graciously given it. Our "you'll thank me later" actually morphs into you'll thank the Provider later. Here's the means to be delivered out of eternal death and translated into eternal life:

Believe on the name of the Lord Jesus Christ and you will be saved. Apply the only sacrifice for sin — the blood of God's sacrificial Lamb, Jesus Christ — to your life. Accept by faith this only provision for sin ... and its consequence, death. Apply the only means to overcome the second death — Jesus Christ's resurrection victory over death — to your life, Accept by faith this provision found only through God. Here are a few related words of Counsel:

Acts 4:12	There's only one name under heaven whereby one can be saved.
John 14:6	Jesus Christ, as He Himself has said, is the way, the truth and the life.
Mt. 7:13, 15	The gate to glorious life is narrow; difficult is the way to life with God.
